## **March 2024 Board Meeting Summary**

The Lake Region Electric Cooperative (LREC) Board of Directors convened at 8:00 a.m. on Thursday, March 28, 2024, at the cooperative's headquarters in Pelican Rapids, Minnesota. The Board of Directors approved the minutes of the February 29, 2024, board meeting. Approval was also given to the consent agenda items of new memberships, capital credit retirements to estates, disbursements, and legal fees.

**CEO Report:** CEO Tim Thompson reported that Minnesota Rural Electric Association (MREA) Safety Director Anthony Lenz recently led an all-employee safety presentation, and that LREC hosted an apprentice line worker training session. Thompson spoke to potential federal grant opportunities, and recapped the MREA Annual Meeting he attended in St. Paul with Directors Kurt Krueger, Gary Olson and Jim Gronbeck.
